



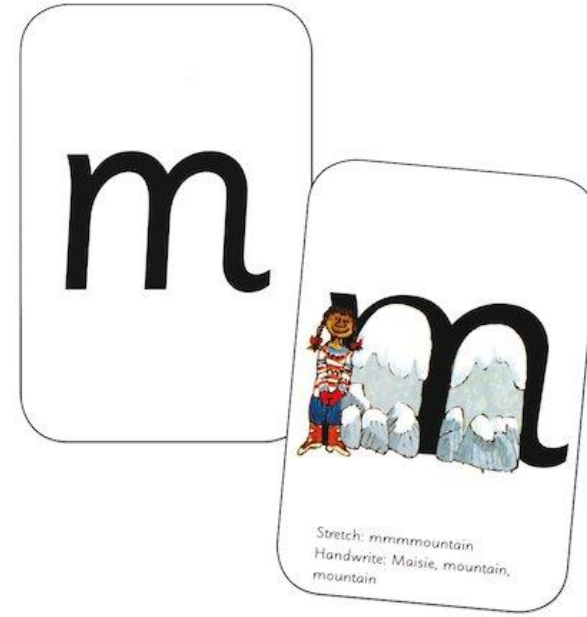
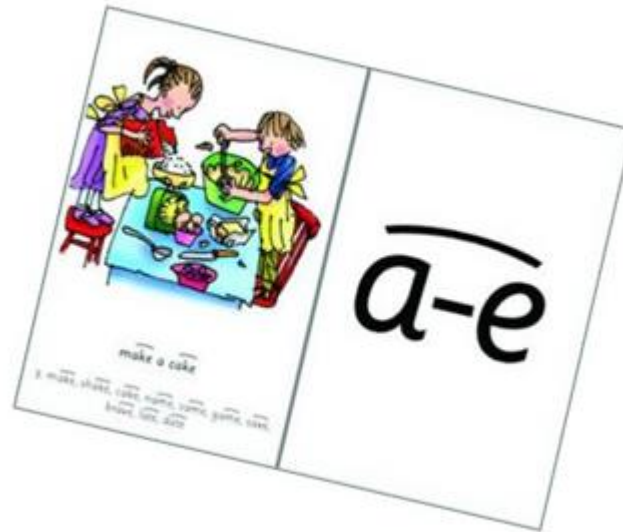

Different types of sounds

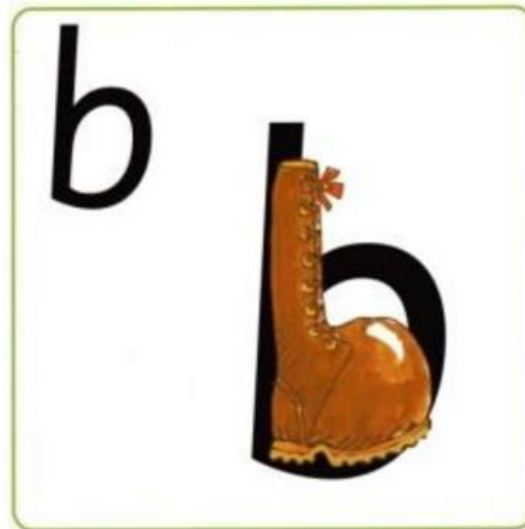
- We learn single sounds - m, a, s etc and special friends - sh, th, air.



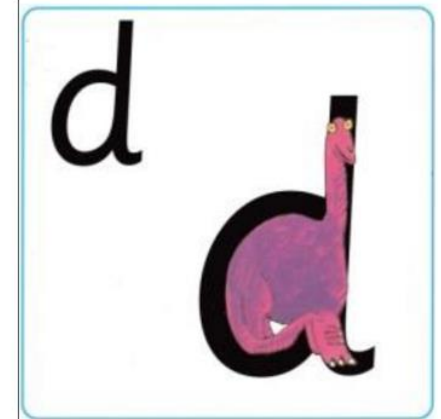
Hooks for Handwriting



Down the pirates plait and around his face.



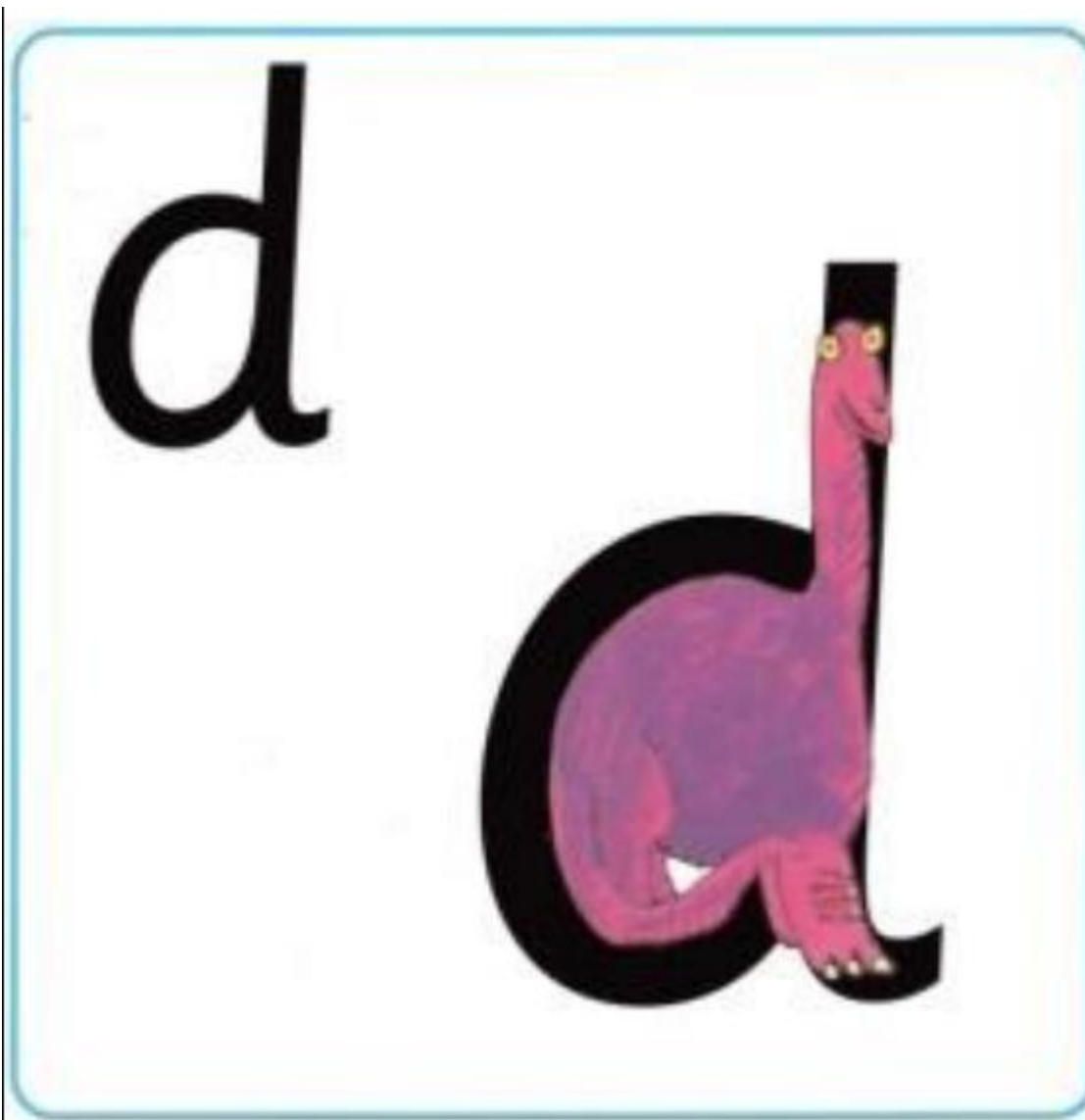
Down the laces to the heel and around the toe.

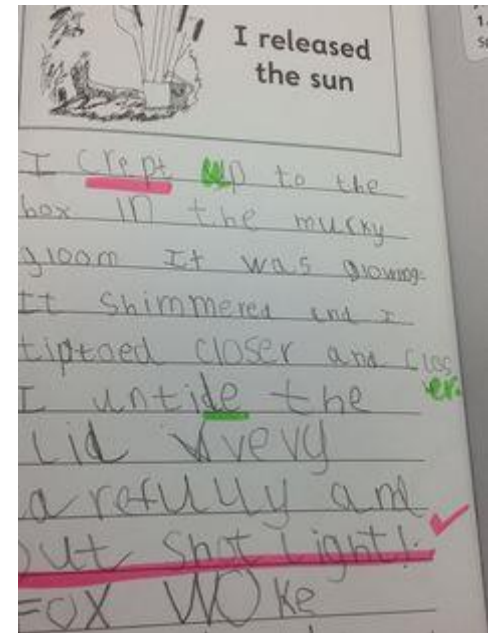
